PRACTICE NOTICE ON ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF EXPERT WITNESSES

General Statement

Expert witnesses have a duty to the Copyright Board to give fair, objective and non-partisan opinion evidence.

Acknowledgement of Expert Witnesses

Expert witnesses who provide a report for use as evidence are required to sign the Board's "Acknowledgement of Expert Witness Form" which is attached to this Practice Notice. In signing, they acknowledge that they will comply with the Board's code of conduct for expert witnesses described in the Form. A signed copy of the Form is to be included in all expert reports filed with the Board.

In the event an expert fails to comply with the Board's code of conduct for expert witnesses, the Board may exclude some or all of the expert's report.
